A Webinar on “**Impact of Indian Freedom Movement in the development of Assamese Literature**” was organised by Department of History and IQAC in Collaboration with Assam College Librarians’ Association (ICT CELL) Jorhat Kendriya Mahavidyalaya, through video conferencing using Zoom platform along with live streaming in Facebook and ICT Cell of Assam College Librarian Association.

The Webinar was organised to remembering the 100 years of Non Cooperation Movement which was launched by Mahatma Gandhi as a part of the Indian Independence Movement. More than 100 participants comprising teachers and students of different educational institutions attended the webinar through Zoom and many more through Facebook. The Webinar started at 4 pm. Mrs Minakshi Borah, Coordinator, hosted the Webinar. The welcome address was delivered by Dr. Ganesh Ch Borah, Principal, Jorhat Kendriya Mahavidyalaya. He briefed about the Non cooperation Movement in Assam which was begun under the banner of Indian National Congress and struggle against the colonial exploitation . He extended a warm welcomed to the Resource Person Dr. Satyakam Borthakur and all the participants of the webinar. Mr. Pranjal Dutta, Coordinator of IQAC also welcomed the participants and opined the purpose and necessity of such webinar. Following by the inaugural address, Dr. Satyakam Borthakur presented his speech. He discussed first how Assam came forefront of the struggle, the involvement of different classes of people. Dr. Borthakur very aptly analysed the growth of Indian Independence Struggle and the growth of Assamese language and literature, its effects, methodically in a lucid manner.
