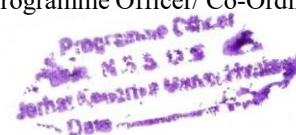
3. NSS SYMBOL:

- 5) Depute teacher for training/orientation etc. when requested for.

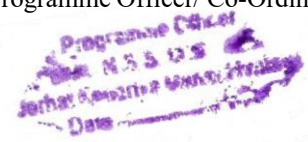

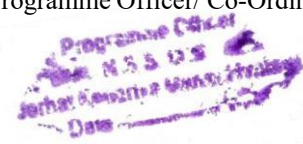


C) PROGRAMME OFFICER:
