

INSTRUCTIONS TO AUTHORS

Authors are invited to submit abstracts (about 500 words) in MS Word by 16th March 2025 on the link given under "submission" on the seminar website.

Abstract should indicate the theme numbers under which it falls, on the upper most corner of the right hand side. Title, Name of Author(s), and affiliations along with Email addresses are must. Template for abstract can be downloaded from the seminar website. Abstract should contain an introductory statement outlining the background and significance of the study, descriptions of the basic methodologies used, a clear indication of the major findings of the study and a concluding statement. All accepted full length papers will be published as seminar proceedings with ISBN code. For final acceptance of the paper, registration of one of the authors is mandatory.

Rules for poster presentation:

- Size of the Poster : 3x4 ft.
- Posters are to be submitted on 28th March 2025.
- A certificate of participation will be awarded to all.
- Participants have to follow the format. Details would be communicated and included in the website in the due course of time.
- Name of the participants and institutions are to be mentioned.

RESEARCH PAPER SUBMISSION GUIDELINE

Abstract Submission: The abstract should be 250-300 words, clearly stating the research background, objectives, methodology, key findings, and conclusions. It should include 4-5 keywords relevant to the research topic.

1. Language: Papers can be submitted in English or Assamese.

2. Format: The paper should follow the APA (7th Edition) format. For Assamese, paper should be written in Ramdhenu Software and Geetanjali font (14-point font) with 1.5 line spacing and 1-inch margins on all sides.

3. Word Limit: Full-length research papers should be between 2,500-5,000 words including references, tables, and figures.

4. Submission Process: The abstract and full paper should be submitted via Email: jkmseminar2025@gmail.com in MS Word (.doc/.docx) format.

5. Author Details: The submission should include the author's name, institutional affiliation, mailing address, phone number, and email address.

6. Co-authorship: A maximum of three co-authors per paper is allowed. For a certificate of participation, each co-author must register separately for the seminar.

7. Originality: All submissions must be original and free from plagiarism. Papers with a similarity index above 10% (excluding references) will be rejected.

8. Presentation Mode: Authors can present their papers either in offline (physical mode) or online (virtual mode).

9. Publication Opportunity: Selected papers may be published in an ISBN- registered edited volume or peer-reviewed journal.

10. Certificates: All registered participants will receive an e-certificate. Hard copies of certificates will be provided to physical participants only.
