Abstract should indicate the Theme Number under which it falls, on the uppermost corner of the right-hand side. Title, name of author (s), and affiliations along with email addresses are must. Template for abstract can be downloaded from the seminar website. Abstract should contain an introductory statement outlining the background and significance of the study, a succinct description of the basic methodologies used, a clear indication of the major findings of the study and a concluding statement. All accepted full length papers will be published as Seminar proceedings with ISBN code. For final acceptance of the paper, registration of one of the authors is mandatory.
