OVERARCHING DEVELOPMENT WITH SPECIAL EMPHASIS ON WOMEN FROM RURAL AREAS-

Jorhat Kendriya Mahavidyalaya (**JKM**) is dedicated in creating an environment in the college which can provide an opportunity to pursue skill courses besides their regularcourses.

JKM is the single Nodal Centre for virtual lab in the North-East Indiawhich is a Ministry of Education recognized Centre under Amrita Viswa Vidyapeetham University.

Jorhat Kendriya Mahavidyalaya (JKM) extends its **consultancy services of green audit and energy audit** to different colleges in its vicinity. Out of the 7 colleges that were audited by JKM consultancy team, CKB College, Teok, Jorhat recently got A+ grade in the NAAC assessment.

An "Incubation and Innovation Cell" was formed in the college on 28th April, 2021 with an aim to create an innovative and entrepreneurial environment in the college campus. IIC-JKM has taken various initiatives to ensure that, especially girl students can get an opportunity to acquire some kind of skill which may help them in their future endeavours to become financially independent.

Some of the initiatives taken by the college are listed below-

- NODAL VIRTUAL LAB- The virtual lab initiative was started in the college in July, 2021under Amrita Viswa Vidyapeetham Universitywith an attempt to carry out laboratory classes virtually on a screen so that the students do not miss out on developing their practical skills during the covid pandemic.
- FORMATION OF INCUBATION AND INNOVATION CELL (IIC)- An "Incubation and Innovation Cell" was formed in the college on 28th April, 2021 which conducts various talks on entrepreneurship to educate the students about the concept of "startups" which will help them to not limit themselves to the concept of pursuing jobs.
- ➤ The IIC, Jorhat Kendriya Mahavidyalaya team helped the team that came from Dr NabinBordoloi College, Cinamora College, Sarbodaya College, Borhola College, Nakachari College, Bahona Boys' H.S. School, Cinamora H.S. School and Jorhat Govt. Girls' H.S. School to register their Institution in IIC, MoE, Govt. of India.
- ➤ The **IIC**, **JKM secured 2 stars** by Innovation Cell, MoE, Govt. of India.
- ➤ The team of IIC, JKM secured the 3rd position in a poster competition held at IICRegional Meet at Royal Global University, 2022.
- ADD ON CERTIFICATE COURSES- The college has started a total number of 8 add on courses for the students since the session 2021-22. Since the college has a lot of students coming from rural areas with poor financial background, these courses mould the students with employable skills which help them to secure jobs in the future.


