Rationale of the event:

It has been envisaged that professionally qualified graduates with a sound knowledge of their core disciplines and expertise in a concerned skill will have more openings in service, industry and self-employment. Soft skills and life skills can make human life more adorable by altering his attitudes & traits and at the same time paving the way for better opportunity and employability.

Soft Skills is a term often associated with a person's ("EQ") Emotional Intelligence Quotient, the cluster of personality traits, social graces, communication, language, personal habits, interpersonal skills, managing people, leadership, etc. that characterize relationships with other people. Life Skills have been defined by the World Health Organization (WHO) as "abilities for adaptive and positive behavior that enable individuals to deal effectively with the demands and challenges of everyday life". They represent the psycho-social skills that determine valued behavior and include reflective skills such as problem-solving and critical thinking, to personal skills such as self-awareness, and interpersonal skills.

It has become essential for higher education institutions to equip the students with Skills that would increase the employability quotient. In this context, the National Seminar and Workshop on "Significance of Soft Skills and Life Skills and its Pertinence in Career Development" is being organized with an aim to bring under one roof academicians and faculty members, researchers and students to share views and ideas about the importance of Soft Skills/Life Skills and its parameters. The seminar is an effort to produce a distinctive way of thinking about how innovations in higher education can influence the quality a student's life.
