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Specific Talk on: National Water Mission

Speaker: Sjt. Bhaskar Jyoti Sharma, Executive Engineer PHE Jorhat.





Mr. Sharma presented a specific talk on National water Mission. National Water Mission is a national initiative in India that aims to conserve, protect and manage the country's water resources. He focused on improving water use efficiency, promoting integrated water resource management, augmenting water supply and promoting conservation and management of water resources. He talked about the aim of NWM which refers to the increase of water use efficiency by creating water storage capacity and implementing river linking projects and also introduced the 5 important goals of NWM:

comprehensive water data base in public domain and assessment of the impact of climate change on water resource. Promotion of citizen and state action for water conservation, augmentation and preservation.

Focused attention to vulnerable areas including over exploited areas.

improving water use efficiency by 20%.

promotion of basin level integrated water resources management.

He addressed the initiative taken by Govt. of India, the Jorhat District Administration & PHE Department for conservation of water. He urged for introduction of vocational courses, skill development courses in educational institutions, which focuses on specific sectoral needs and promoting self employment in different sectors. 


