Drawing & Disbursement Officers (DDO) are basically the Head of the Offices. In discharging the duties, the head of the offices are to deal with the fund assigned to them through budget for drawl and disbursement in connection with his office functions. In other words, he is the Finance Manager of his Office.

#### **Duties and responsibilities**

1. Budget (Budget Manual, FRBM Act)

2. Entering into liabilities – procurements (AFR)

3. Establishment (FR-SR, Service Rules, Pension Rules, other employee benefit Rule)

4. Claims (AFR)

5. Sanction & Ceiling (AFR, DFP Rules, Budget Manual)

6. Receipts/Payments (AFR)

7. Accounts (AFR, Govt. accounting Rule)

8. Returns (Budget Manual)

9. Audits (AG's Audit Manual)

#### **Duties of Drawing and Disbursing Officer**

- A Govt. servant authorized to draw money by cheques is to be notified to the bank and treasury about the no. of each cheque book being brought in to use.
- He is also to send specimen signature of the relieving Govt. servant, duly attested by head of office, to the Treasury Officer and the bank.

The Treasury Rules and Subsidiary Orders need amendments and deletions due to many changes including computerization of treasuries and sub-treasuries under CTMIS.

- DDOs and Heads of Offices have critical role in ensuring compliance to existing Treasury Rules and Subsidiary Orders.
- Monthly reconciliation of expenditure and receipts should be given due importance. DDOs should have regular & closer interaction with the Treasury Officer.

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








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
