The vision of higher education in India is to realize the country's human resource potential to its fullest with equity and inclusion. The higher education sector, in recent decades, has witnessed a tremendous growth in many aspects such as its institutional capacity, enrolment, teacher-student ratio, etc. Equity, access and quality education to all

is the core focus of National Education Policy 2020. The spirit and intent of the NEP 2020 is commendable but achievement of the goals and targets is a challenging task. Any major reforms or revision particularly in an educational system is accompanied with multiple challenges emanating from many critical aspects. It is very appreciable that the NEP 2020 is very influencing and also may be very fruitful. By 2040, all HEIs shall aim to become multidisciplinary institutions, each of which will aim to have 3000 or more students. But, as far as its implementation aspect is concerned; some challenges such as infrastructure issues, to increase gross enrolment ratio at least 50% by 2035, financial constraints etc., may come up in front of the processes which are by and large same for every corner of the country. 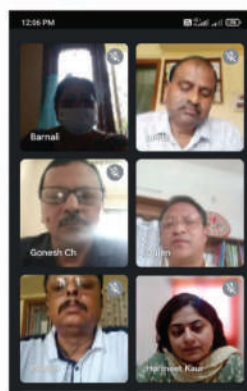

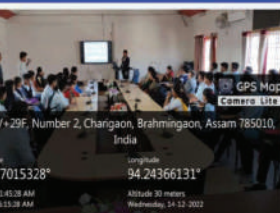
National Energy Conservation Day

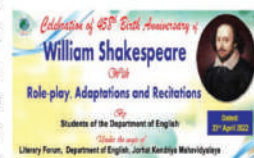

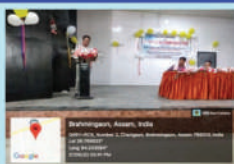
Extempore Speech

5. Lightening of lamp

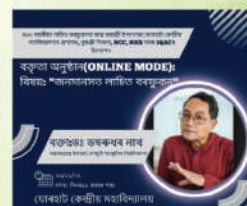
On this occasion students, 112 number of students, faculty members wrote essay on Lachit Borphukan.

Its main objective is to procure, organize, preserve, disseminate information in all fields of knowledge to serve the institutional, curricular, research, recreational needs of the college community.

Library Services and Facilities

ILMS in the Library: The library is an automated one since 2015 with the leading software SOUL2.0 provided by INFLIBNET Centre. The library management software gives a user friendly interface for delivering timely services to the users under client-server environment. At present the housekeeping operations like cataloguing, circulation, barcoding, member log in, access to library catalogue through



OPAC etc. have been done by using SOUL 2.0 ILMS

Barcode Technology:

Barcode-based digital attendance system for students are placed at the library entrance while visiting the library. Barcode Technology has also been using in circulating the books.

Searching through

OPAC: Since the library is automated one, the holdings of the library can be searched using OPAC (Online Public Access Catalogue).

Wi-Fi-based Library: The College Library is Wi-Fi based library. Library users can use the Wi-Fi service in the reading hall and in the digital library section.

Digital Library Section: The library has a separate digital library section. 7 (Seven) computers have been installed in the library and all are connected to the internet. Along with these, a specific time from 2.30pm to 3.30pm is allotted in the computer lab for library use.

Membership of E-Contents: The Library is a member of e-ShodhSindhu consortium which provide access to 6000+ e-journals, 1,99,500+ e-books under NList and 6,00,000+ e-books through National Digital Library (NDL)

WhatsApp-based circulation: Students and faculty members of Jorhat Kendriya Mahavidyalaya are connected with the library through 3 (Three) WhatsApp Groups. All important information, notices, new arrival of books etc. are shared in those groups

Reprographic and Printing Service : Students avail these facilities in the library in a nominal fee.

User Orientation: A User Orientation and Awareness Programme is done every year at the beginning of the new academic session to make the students aware of various library services and facilities.

Question Paper Facility: The students can consult previous year question papers in the library .They avail soft copies of the question papers also.

Suggestion Box: The library staff feel happy to get feedback from the users. So regular feedbacks are taken from the students. A suggestion box is also kept for getting suggestions for future improvement.
