

One Day Workshop Organised by CKB College Teok Under the Friendship Cluster Union of Sorhat Kendreja Mahavidyalaya, Amguri College and Teok CKB College Teok. Dated: 10.01.2022. (4)

The Meeting was attended by ten delegates from each college under cluster union.
Proceeding of the Meeting -

An action plan of the Cluster Friendship Union envisaged by the esteemed principals of C.K.B College Teok, Amguri College and SKM namely, Dr. Bijay Krishna Pachari, Dr. Asfia Sultana and Dr. Dulen Saikia respectively, was reviewed on 15th of November 2021. As per discussion an MOU signing ceremony was held at Amguri College on the 13th December 2021. The first event after the signing of the MOU - the One-Day Workshop on Innovation, Incubation & Start-up programme was organised in CKB College Teok and was attended by 10 delegates from each of the colleges besides involvement of the entire faculty of the college contributing to the grand success of the workshop.

The inauguration of the workshop was accentuated by a 'Bhogali Mela' by students and community members. The actual inaugural programme of the workshop began at 10.45 AM with a briefing on the objectives of the workshop by Dr. Binaykrat Rajkhowa, IQAC Co-ordinator, Teok CKB college. The chairperson for this part of the meeting was Dr. B. K. Pachari who spoke about the relevance of such activities in the NEP. This cluster union experiments the possibilities that such unions may offer. He spoke on its advantages and disadvantages. The first initiative was undertaken by inviting

Students of the two participating colleges under the cluster union to join the Cultural Training Workshop in CKB College Teok. This event wherein as many as eleven training programmes organised by the college was joined by selected students of the three participating colleges under cluster union and proved hugely fruitful. He concluded with the hope that the cluster union will prove to be successful.

The workshop was inaugurated by Dr. Rupom Saikia, Inspector of Colleges, Dibrugarh Univ. In his valuable speech, Dr. Rupom Saikia elaborated on the multi disciplinary concept introduced by NEP. He expressed his view that this platform would help immensely in encouraging and inspiring budding entrepreneurs. He opined that innovation results in Creativity. When an idea is settled through consensus, it is long lasting. Knowledge & resources shared in the manner will promote healthy competition. He also pointed out that the benefits must percolate down to the grassroot level and that such activities also help us realise the extent of our ignorance. According to Dr. Saikia, the correct way to start is by identifying the problem & the obstacles, next, to seek solutions. The solution will prove to be the key to success. He praised the initiative taken by the dynamic principals in this regard and said that "This is the need of the hour."

The second part of the inaugural session was chaired by Dr. Asfia Sultana who opened an interactive session on the main aspects of the MoU. This session brought to light several healthy initiatives already in practice in the colleges and ample scope for one college to share resource with the other, be it intellectual resource that may be shared through teacher exchange programme or physical or spatial resource. The chairperson requests Dr. Duler Saikia Sir to present the action plan for set-up of Innovation and Incubation Centres (IIC) in participating institutions under the cluster friendship MoU and also to provide a road map for the year. In an hourlong deliberation Dr. Duler Saikia, principal JKN, explained several aspects of IICs and ways of channelising so as to create a vibrant eco-system. To conceive an idea, to experiment on it and to transform the idea into a product requires interest and perseverance and this is the core function of an IIC. Besides highlighting the functions of IICs, He elaborated on the use of institutional resources, infrastructural facilities, services and support for the purpose for the growth of IICs. Among future activities as part of the road map for the year he underlined the following:

- Traditional Knowledge Digital Library

- IP Literacy and Awareness programme.
- Start-up for Self venture.
- Social Entrepreneurship - Experiencing the journey of an Entrepreneur: Empowering Tribal Artisans.
- Self Employment opportunities for Educated youth in collaboration with MSME
- National Conclave on "Institution Incubation Innovation Centre and its prospectives and challenges in North-East India".

The presentation was followed by an interactive session in which respected principals of the three institutions addressed the queries from amongst the delegates present. It was decided that each member would identify at least one plausible idea for incubation and present the same in the next sitting of the IQAC co-ordinators and their associates on the 27th of January 2020. ^{A minimum of 30 start-up programmes.} It was also decided that a detailed strategy regarding the conclave to be organised jointly by the colleges under cluster union will also be discussed in the said meeting. The workshop concluded with the distribution of certificates to all participants and the vote of Thanks by Dr. Binaybrat Rajthara of CKC College Teok.



He not only demonstrated the entire process of registration in TIDE, Assam Startup and IAC etc. but also helped the representatives register successfully in IAC. The discussion then moved on to the second subject in the agenda. The Mega Event of startup to be organized as a collaborative venture of the three colleges under 'Friendship Cluster Union'.

The following were the main decision of the meeting: -

1. That all Colleges under Friendship Cluster Union would register in the IAC
2. The Venue for organising the mega event the conclave would be NEIST.
3. Sponsorship for the Conclave must be sought from the following institution-
(a) NEIST (b) USTM (c) Kaziranga University (d) Rain Forest Research Institute
(e) Assam Startups (f) Oil India Ltd. (g) NRL & ONGC
4. Drive for registrations of at least 60 institutions in IAC & Other Websites
5. Tentative date for the Conclave was set for Oct 10th to 12th 2022.

The meeting turned out to be a fruitful one. There was exchange of ideas regarding startups and consultancies on ways of moving ahead successfully. The meeting came to and end with the vote of thanks by coordinator IQAC, JKM, MrPranjal Dutta.
