 (This portal will be Live after launch by Hon'ble President of India in the function starting at 11 AM on 26th November, 2021 from Central Hall of Parliament House).

It is requested that all the officers, staff and students of the Universities and their affiliated/ constituent colleges may also join the Hon'ble President in mass reading of the Preamble at 11.00 AM on 26th November, 2021 from their respective offices/ locations. Webinars/ workshops/ any other program or activity may also be organized befitting the occasion while giving wide publicity and keeping the COVID protocols in mind.

PREAMBLE

WE, THE PEOPLE OF INDIA, having solemaly resolved to constitute India into a SOVEREIGN SOCIALIST SECULAR DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC and to secure to all its citaten:

JUSTICE, social, economic and political;

LIBERTY of thought, expression, belief, faith and worship;

EQUALITY of status and of opportunity;

and to promote among them all

FRATERNITY assuring the dignity of the individual and the unity

and integrity of the Nation;

IN OUR CONSTITUENT ASSEMBLY this twenty - sixth day

of November, 1949, do HEREBY ADOPT, ENACT AND GIVE

TO OURSELVES THIS CONSTITUTION.
