“Guidelines for Admission into 1st Semester Undergraduate Programme (Academic Session: 2026–27)”, the admission guidelines are:

1st Semester UG Admission Guidelines (2026–27)

Documents to Bring

1. Bring a printed copy of the duly submitted Institution and Subject-specific Application Form from the SAMARTH portal.
2. Bring the **original copies** of all uploaded documents, including:
 - o Mark sheets and certificates of all examinations
 - o HSLC Admit Card (age proof)
 - o Aadhaar Card
 - o Caste Certificate (if applicable)
 - o Income Certificate (for fee waiver applicants)
 - o EWS Certificate (if applicable)
 - o Any other documents uploaded on the SAMARTH portal

3. Reserved Category Applicants

- Candidates applying under any **Reserved Category/Quota** must submit original caste certificates issued by the competent authority.
- **NCL Certificate** is mandatory for OBC/MOBC candidates.

4. Gap Certificate Requirement

- Students who passed 10+2 in 2024 or 2025 must submit a **Gap Certificate or Affidavit** explaining the reason for the gap.

5. Admission Confirmation

- Admission will be confirmed only after successful verification of all submitted documents.

- Other admission-related issues/queries will be addressed on the day of admission.

6. Fee Waiver Scheme Guidelines

Eligibility:

- The fee waiver scheme will be implemented subject to the official notification/SOP issued by the Government of Assam.
- The scheme is **not applicable** for:
B.Voc

Required Documents for Fee Waiver:

- Applicants seeking fee waiver must submit:
 - Income Certificate from the Local Revenue Circle Office, or
 - Ration Card issued by the competent authority.
- Annual family income must **not exceed ₹4 lakh**.


7. Disqualification for Fee Waiver

5. An applicant is **not eligible** for the fee waiver scheme if either parent (mother or father) is employed in:

- State Government
- Central Government
- Semi-Government organizations
- State/Central Government undertakings

8. Additional Requirement

All students must submit a duly filled Anti-Ragging Form/Undertaking on the day of admission before the Anti-Ragging Committee.
